## Pattern knitting

There are 25 different Punch cards with the machine.

Using these 25 basic cards, it is possible to knit 70 different fancy stitch patterns. The following 64 pictures of swatch are knitted by using Punch cards. An instruction of each pattern is explained on pages 42 to 55.

It is recommended to use the Punch card marked O for each pattern knitting.


